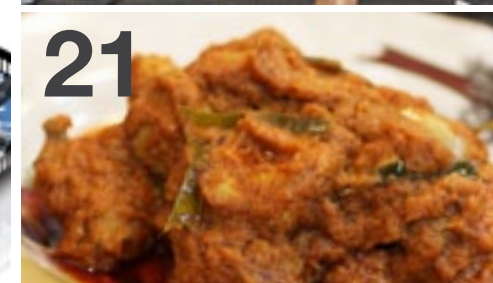

13 MAR 2015 – 8 APR 2015

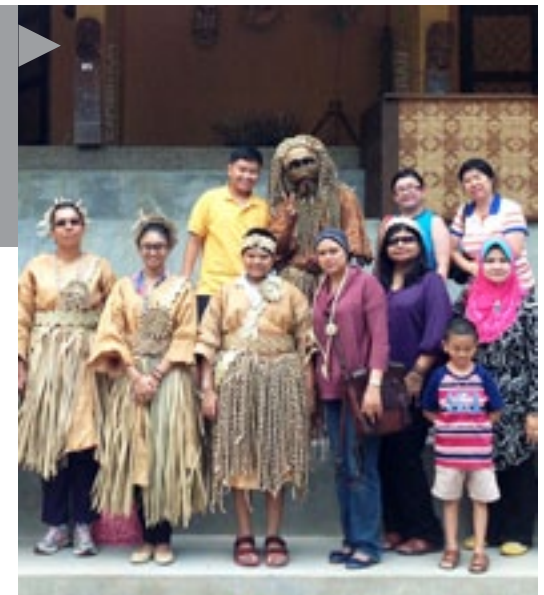

Malaysia's Proud Achievements

58 years after achieving independence, Malaysia has become an industrialised, economically expanding centre of multiculturalism and modernity fuelled by its strategic location and abundance of natural resources. This Merdeka, we look back at some of Malaysia's proudest achievements and milestones, especially infrastructures comprised of national icons and landmarks that led to our country's success.



1983

Proton

- The first and sole Malaysian car brand before the advent of Perodua in 1993
- The first Proton, called Saga, was produced in a joint venture with Mitsubishi Motors brokered by Tun Dr Mahathir bin Mohamad
- Has a presence in 26 countries

1985

The Penang Bridge

- This dual-carriageway toll bridge spans 13.5 km (8.4 km over water), and is Southeast Asia's fifth-longest bridge
- It was the first and only bridge connecting the peninsula and the island until 2014, when the second Penang bridge was built

1994

PLUS Expressway (North-South Expressway)

- Malaysia's longest expressway at a total length of 772 km
- Connects major cities and towns in the west of the Malaysian peninsula from Bukit Kayu Hitam in Kedah to Johor Bahru, the "backbone" of the west coast

In the early 1990s, WCT was involved in various subcontract jobs along this highway including site clearance, earthworks, drainage, road and pavement works:

- North-South Expressway, Section 8A-2: Simpang Pulai to Gopeng
- North-South Expressway, Kulai to Skudai
- North-South Interurban Tollway, Package 8B-1A
- North-South Expressway Central Link and KLIA Expressway, Package 2A

In July 2012, WCT was awarded the RM391 million Fourth Lane Widening project between Nilai (kilometre 280.4) and Seremban (kilometre 258.5).

1995

Putrajaya

- Administrative centre of the federal government of Malaysia
- The world's first Intelligent Garden City with a botanical garden, 70 acres of lush equestrian park, and a vast lake for refreshing recreation
- Malaysia's third Federal Territory since 2001
- By 2012, most of the government ministries were successfully moved to Putrajaya
- Located within the Multimedia Super Corridor
- Features monuments such as the National Heroes Square, Millennium Monument and Putrajaya Landmark
- WCT was involved in the construction and completion of Lot 3C4, Lot 2G3, Lot 2G4, Lot 4G8 and Lot 4G9. Lot 2C5 is in the works at the time of writing

Kuala Lumpur Tower

- Seventh-tallest freestanding tower in the world at 421 m (1,382 ft)
- The top four floors of the tower's head have been set aside for free-to-air terrestrial television and radio broadcasting
- The highest viewpoint in Kuala Lumpur that is open to the public
- A public observation deck, open deck, revolving restaurant, banquet hall, XD theatre, and F1 simulator zone occupy the tower's head
- The tower contains three basement floors that are vital for safety purposes, and used as a storage and maintenance area

Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA)

- Malaysia's largest and busiest international airport and one of the major airports of Southeast Asia
- Built at a cost of USD3.5 billion in Sepang, Selangor
- The first and only airport in the world to be recipient of the Green Globe 21 Certificate
- Voted as the World's Best Airport at the AETRA 2005, ACI-ASQ 2006,

and ACI-ASQ 2007 awards, when it averaged between 15 and 25 million passengers per annum

- WCT undertook the bulk earthworks contract, slope protection and horizontal drainage works as well as the construction and completion of the main platform area, perimeter road, central and northern retention pond. WCT successfully moved and handled 50 million cubic metres of earth which represented half of the earthworks involved in the construction of KLIA.

Sepang International Circuit

- Malaysia's international motor-racing hub
- Has a 1.3km long double frontage grandstand that overlooks the circuit's longest straights
- The 15 turns and 8 straights that make up the track's 5.543km allow for speeds in excess of 300km/h
- From the aerial view, it signifies the hibiscus, the national flower of Malaysia
- In recognition of its ultramodern facilities, it was accorded the right to incorporate the F1 logo into its name
- WCT constructed the circuit in a record time of 14 months and was awarded the CIDB Malaysian Construction Industry Excellence Award's 2001 Special Projects Award

Learn these recipes to prepare traditional Aidilfitri delicacies and snacks that are bound to delight your Open House guests. With these simple, quick and easy guides, you will be able to uphold lasting traditions and create even fonder memories of your Raya festivities.

MAKMUR COOKIES

Ingredients: For the dough

- 750 grams of plain/ all-purpose flour
- 200 – 300 grams butter, softened
- 2 tablespoons ghee or clarified butter
- 1 teaspoon salt
- Food colouring

For the filling

- 150 grams butter, softened
- 150 grams icing sugar
- 400 grams groundnuts, roasted and grounded coarsely

Method:

Making the dough

1. Sift flour into a bowl and add salt. Next, add ghee or clarified butter and mix well with the flour. Use your hands to mix the ghee.
2. Add the butter, a little at a time. Knead well. Once your dough is firm and you can shape it without crumbling, stop adding butter.
3. Add your choice of food colouring to the dough (normally 2 – 3 drops is sufficient) and knead well until the dough is coloured.
4. Form balls of dough then set aside.

Putting everything together

1. Take a ball of dough and press the ball between your index finger and thumb. Let the index finger make a deep well into the dough by pressing down.
2. As you do this, use the thumb and index finger of your other hand to touch the dough and rotate it. Rotate the ball as your index finger makes a well.
3. Once you have made a deep well, insert a ball of peanut paste and cover it with the dough.
4. Seal the opening and shape your cookie like a leaf.
5. This is optional, but if you have a pair of pincers, make a leaf pattern on the dough.
6. Place your cookies on a baking tray lined with greaseproof paper and bake for 30 minutes at 160 Degrees Celsius.



Making the filling

1. Dry roast the groundnuts and remove the skin.
2. Crush the groundnuts coarsely by using an electric blender or pound groundnuts using a pestle and mortar (which will take a longer time).
3. Once all the groundnuts are crushed, add butter and sugar then mix well.
4. Form balls out of the groundnuts so that you can easily insert them into the dough later. Set aside.



DODOL

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 lb gula Melaka
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 pandan leaf
- 1 cup glutinous rice flour
- 1 tablespoon rice flour
- 400ml of coconut cream
- 100ml of water

Method:

1. Combine sugar, gula Melaka, water and pandan leaf and cook on "high" for five minutes.
2. Stir and cook further if sugar has not dissolved.
3. Add in glutinous rice flour, rice flour, coconut cream and water. Stir well and strain mixture.
4. Cook on "high" at 3-minute intervals, stirring vigorously at every interval.
5. Continue to cook and stir until mixture thickens, becomes shiny and does not stick to finger when touched.
6. Discard the pandan leaf and transfer dodol to a greased clingwrap. Wrap up well and leave to set.

MAZOLA COOKIES



Ingredients:

- 2 cups sifted flour
- 1 1/4 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/3 cup Mazola oil
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 egg plus milk to make 1/3 cup

Method:

1. Sift flour, baking powder and salt into bowl.
2. Add Mazola oil, blend well with spatula or hand mixer.
3. Beat sugar, vanilla and egg-milk mixture together until it is very light and fluffy.
4. Stir into flour mixture. Chill for about 1 hour.
5. Roll out on a floured board or cloth and cut as desired.
6. Bake in oven at 400 degrees Celsius for about 9 minutes. Makes 3 dozen.

SPICY CHICKEN RENDANG

Ingredients:

Chicken:

- 1kg chicken cleaned and cut into medium sized pieces
- 1/2 tablespoon turmeric powder
- Salt

Rendang Paste Ingredients (A):

- 6 tablespoons dried chilli paste
- 7 shallots
- 5 cloves garlic
- 1 large onion
- 1 inch ginger
- 10 bird's eye chillies
- 5 stalks lemongrass
- 2 candlenuts (buah keras)
- 1/2 inch fresh turmeric
- 2 inches galangal
- Sufficient water to form a paste

Other Ingredients:

- 200ml coconut milk
- 2 pieces tamarind pulps
- 2 stalks lemongrass (slightly bruised)
- 5 pieces kaffir lime leaves or 2 pieces turmeric leaves thinly sliced
- 2 tablespoons kerisik (toasted and pounded coconut)
- Salt to taste
- Cooking oil



Method:

1. Marinade chicken pieces with turmeric powder and salt for 30 minutes.
2. Blend Rendang Paste Ingredients (A) together until smooth.
3. Heat oil in wok and fry chicken pieces until 3/4 cooked. Set aside.
4. Use same oil to sauté the blended ingredients together with the bruised lemongrass.
5. Stir the gravy and cook covered for 25 – 30 minutes. Stir occasionally to avoid burnt bottom.
6. Once oil separates from gravy, add coconut milk, tamarind pulps and salt.
7. Stir and allow to boil a few times. Add fried chicken pieces and kaffir lime leaves.
8. Mix well and cover with lid for another 10 minutes. Stir.
9. Add toasted coconut, mix evenly. Check for salt. Serve.

KETUPAT DAUN PALAS WITH KUAH KACANG

Ingredients for Ketupat Daun Palas:

- 2.5kg glutinous rice
- 4 coconuts or 3kg coconut milk
- ½ kg uncooked groundnuts, boiled (optional)
- Palas (Licuala palm leaves)



Method:

1. Wash uncooked glutinous rice under running water until clean. Transfer to colander and allow to dry.
2. Heat coconut milk with a little salt in a large pot or wok until it simmers.
3. Add the glutinous rice and stir continuously until the rice is half cooked. For extra bite and flavour, add boiled peanuts to the mixture and stir. Leave to cool.
4. Take a small portion of the cooled glutinous rice and place it in the center of the palm fronds. Weave the fronds into a triangular shape.
5. Immerse the wrapped rice into a vat of boiling water and leave until cooked. Cooked glutinous rice is usually quite soft when pressed.

Ingredients for Kuah Kacang:

- 1kg peanuts (blended)
- 3 stalks of lemongrass
- 1 inch ginger
- 1 inch galangal/ lengkuas
- 1 inch fresh turmeric
- 1 tablespoon turmeric powder
- 4 – 5 tablespoons of brown sugar
- 4 – 5 tablespoons palm sugar
- 15 dried chillies soaked in hot water
- 20 onion shallots
- 6 cloves of garlic
- 2 boxes of coconut milk
- 5 tablespoons tamarind paste
- Salt
- Cooking oil



Method:

1. Blend together lemongrass, ginger, galangal, turmeric, sugar, chillies, shallots and garlic.
2. Stir blended ingredients in a heated wok or pan.
3. Add in cooking oil and keep stirring.
4. Add in coconut milk and tamarind paste. Bring to a boil, lower heat and simmer for 5 minutes.
5. Add in the ground peanuts and simmer until oil forms on the surface.
6. Check for consistency – the sauce should be thick.
7. Add about 1 tablespoon of salt and sugar to taste. Remove from heat and serve with ketupat.
